Seeds rot or never emerge. Sow with depth.

■ SEED SIZE → DEPTH RULE

● TINY SEEDS

Sow on surface

● SMALL SEEDS

1/4 inch (6mm) deep

□ MEDIUM SEEDS

1/2 inch (12mm) deep

● LARGE SEEDS

1 inch (25mm) deep

☀ LIGHT VS DARK GERMINATORS

● LIGHT GERMINATORS

- Lettuce, Spinach, Coriander
- Most leafy greens
- Cover with thin soil layer

● DARK GERMINATORS

- Tomato, Chilli, Beans
- Gourds, Melons
- Cover 2-3x seed depth

❗ COMMON SOWING ERRORS

🚫 Too deep: Seed runs out of energy before emerging
 🚫 Overcrowding: Seedlings compete and die

🚫 Too shallow: Seed dries out or gets eaten by birds
 🚫 Wrong timing: Sowing in wrong season leads to bolting

REDUCES "BAD SEEDS" BLAME

When seeds don't grow, people blame the seeds. Most often, it's the sowing depth or timing.
